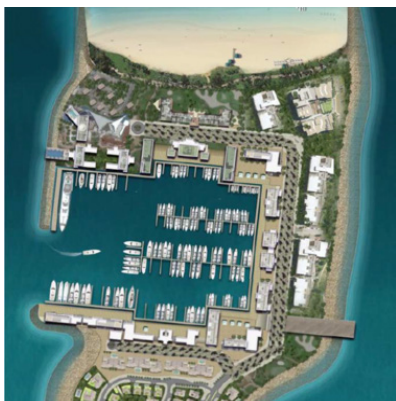


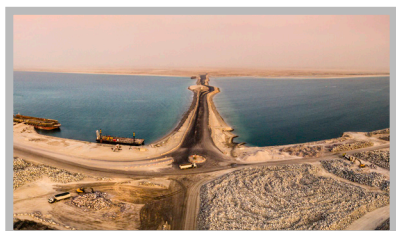

Port De La Mer Contract: Dredging, Reclamation, Soil Improvement & Protection Works

The Company is pleased to announce the resumption of Port De La Mer Project by Meraas on the 1st November 2016. The extension of the waterfront La Mer Development at Jumeirah includes an island extension at the North Peninsula that is extending approximately 700m sea ward and 130,000sq.m in area. The new port island will feature berthing for a minimum of 150 Vessels, three Hotels Yacht Club, retail area around the Marina, and residential apartments. Projects Link scope of works includes 1500 lm of island shore protection rock works, 4.5 Million cubic meter of dredging, reclamation & soil improvement, 120,000 cubic meters demolition of temporary shore protection along the offshore edge of the existing North Peninsula, construction of 500 lm long beach and groynes, 1,250 lm long quay wall with pre-cast concrete blocks, and 6,500 m³ of cast-in-place concrete crown walls. Works will also include supply and install of marina furniture – fenders, 30 T bollards and ladders .
